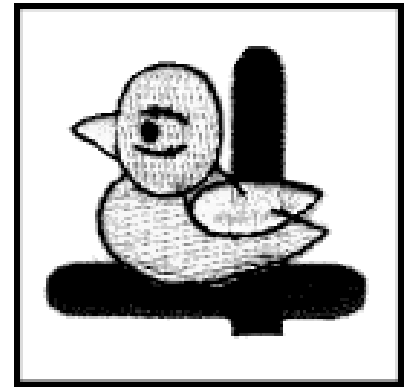


CRAFT STICK AND WOOD FUN



1. Of what are craft sticks and “woodls” made?
2. Besides craft projects, where else have you seen this type of stick used?
3. Explain what “Woodls” are?
4. How do you put these together?
5. How can you decorate and finish these projects?
6. Make a seed marker or a light “pull” of craft sticks.
7. Make a planter trivet or a picture frame of craft sticks.
8. Make a napkin holder of craft sticks, or your choice.
9. Make a free-standing figure or letter holder of “woodls” (your choice) or a “magnet” for the kitchen.
10. Make a wall plaque with “woodls”.

HELPS:

1. Wood
2. Ice cream on sticks and tongue depressors
3. “Woodls” are die cut hardwood shapes (squares, triangles, circles, oval, or teardrops). Glue together with white or craft glue. May be stained, dyed, or painted.
4. Glue

“Woodls” are sold at Wal-Mart and craft supply stores.
