6. Draw or color a picture of your favorite sea creature.
7. Make and label a picture of 5 different sea creatures. (May include shells, sand dollars, lobsters, etc.)
8. Of what use is the ocean to us. Name 5 things.

2. Show children a map of the U.S. and locate the Pacific and Atlantic Oceans. Observe the Gulf of Mexico and Atlantic Ocean and discuss where they are in relation to Florida.
